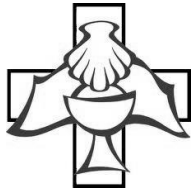

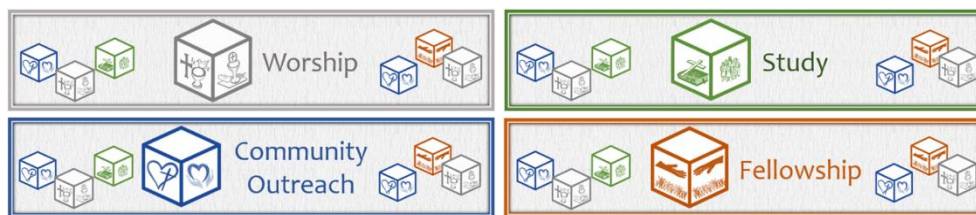

- **Thanksgiving Eve Divine Service & Tree Trimming**

We will gather for the Thanksgiving Eve service on Wednesday, November 27th at 7:15. Because of the short turn-around in preparing for the First Sunday in Advent, we will incorporate a brief devotion focused on transitioning from Pentecost to Advent at the end of this service and then decorate the Sanctuary Chrismon tree.

- **Advent Services – Sundays and Wednesdays**

This year's theme for Advent will incorporate both the Sunday and Wednesday services. On Sundays, the focus will be on the Old Testament lessons from the prophets as they speak of the first Advent of Christ. On Wednesdays we will focus on the traditional Epistle lessons for Advent which, for the age of the Church, speak of the second Advent of Christ. Finally, on Christmas, we will focus on that gospel proclamation of the appearing of Christ and the salvation that He brings.

- **Sunday School / Day School Christmas Program**

The Christmas Program will be held at the 11:15 service on Sunday, December 8th.

- **Voters Meeting**

The final Voters Meeting of 2024 will be on Sunday, December 8th at 9:45 am. This meeting will be to approve the 2025 Ministry Plan.
